Outside the Box Thinking

This award is in recognition of a catering team or person who has shown to be pushing the boundaries with what can be done within school meals to encourage uptake, entice children to try new tastes and make them an enjoyable experience. * NEW * CATEGORY *

The winner will receive a trophy, framed certificate and prosecco.

The winner must have shown development of innovative ideas, enthusiasm and the ability to 'try something new'. This could include but not be limited to theme days, staff participation, pupil rewards schemes, parent involvement and other ways to excite children about their school lunch, breakfast or after school meal.

The judges will be looking for examples of creative thinking and evidence that the events have had a positive impact on the children, their uptake of healthy eating and an understanding of the food they are enjoying. The judges will need to see the school menu or timetable which demonstrates examples of how these activities are incorporated into the children's school lives, how parents are included and kept in the loop and how the whole school community is involved.
